Report Cards

Report cards will be sent home with students on Wednesday, November 7. If you have questions, please contact the teacher who has given the grade you are questioning. Please remember, teachers are guided by report card rubrics for each area in which a student receives a grade. In past quarters of instruction, these grading rubrics for each area were posted on the LPS website. They were inadvertently removed from the site and will be reposted soon. However, all teachers have copies of the rubrics for which you are invited to view and we have copies in the office.

Student Dismissal

We are making a few minor adjustments to our dismissal procedures. We will no longer "direct" traffic into the car pool lane for personal liability reasons. However, we continue to stress to drivers to NOT turn left into the car pool lane off of 75th Street. This "clogs" the entrance of the car pool lane and affects the efficiency of picking up students. In addition, it is just not "fair" to turn left in front of vehicles when others have been waiting in line to get into the car pool lane driving north off of 75th Street.

You will notice that we are no longer using our stop signs in the crosswalks located off school property. To avoid any confusion or misunderstanding of us "directing traffic", our signs now read, "Crosswalk". We ask everyone to continue to obey the traffic law that gives students and adults the "right of way" in all crosswalks. This means that drivers need to drive slowly on 75th Street and be prepared to stop when students and/or adults enter into crosswalks. No one wishes to have a pedestrian hit by a vehicle.

We also continue to ask drivers of personal vehicles using the parking lot to find a parking stall and park their cars. We still ask all students to be escorted by adults when walking in the parking lot. We request that personal vehicles not "stand" in the parking lot or next to the curb in the north car pool lane.

Return to Standard Time

Please remember to set your clocks "back" one hour on Saturday evening/Sunday morning to return to standard time. Beginning at 2:00 a.m. on Sunday, November 4, we will no longer be on Day Light Savings Time.
