2008-2009 After School Enrichment Supervisor Needed

The Maxey PTO is seeking a responsible parent or teacher to serve as a Student Supervisor for the PTO's After School Enrichment program. The Student Supervisor is responsible for monitoring students in the gym between the end of the regular school day and the beginning of After School classes, taking attendance of students and confirming absences through the school office and/or phone calls to parents, and ensuring that all students have departed at the end of After School classes.

The hours required vary from semester to semester depending on scheduling of classes, but is approximately one hour per day (3:38 pm to 4:45 pm), three to four days per week, twelve weeks per semester. (The exact schedule will be coordinated each semester by the PTO's After School Enrichment committee chair. After School classes for the current semester are scheduled to begin the first week of October.) The position is compensated at \$7 per student participating in the program, per semester. (For example, if 100 students participate, the Student Supervisor receives \$700 for that semester.) In addition, the Student Supervisor's own children may participate in After School classes for free.
